All campers must wear their Camp Fremont T-shirt in order to participate in a field trip. This is necessary to increase visibility for counselors and ensure that all campers are safe and accounted for.

Be on time: It is important that all campers are dropped off by 8:45. Late arrivals will cause us to miss our pre-determined destination times. We will do our best to return by 3:30. If we are late, please remain at the school until the bus arrives.
What to bring: Be sure to pack a lunch. Lunch will not be offered as part of any of our trips. Occasionally we will visit places that have gift shops. Please make sure that your child has any money secured. Dress according to the day's activities. Ask counselors what you may need.

SIGN IN/OUT POLICY

Each camper will be required to be signed in and out of camp every day. If anyone other than a camper's parent/guardian is signing their child out of camp, a pick-up/sign-out sheet must be completed. This person will need identification. If you would like to grant your camper permission to walk home after camp, a signed permission slip will be required.

CAMP POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Lunch: Lunch will not be provided. Please pack your child a lunch.

Snack: We will provide two snack times daily. Please provide your child with a snack and preferably enough food to sustain them for the day.

Fluids : Water fountains will be accessible. However, we encourage you to also pack plenty for your child to drink. Campers become dehydrated easily in the summer heat. Packing a reusable water bottle is required

Lost and Found:!We will maintain a lost and found in the gym.

Medications and Special Conditions: The Camp Director should be made aware of all medical conditions, or medications needed to be taken by your child, and any other special concerns you may have.

Dress: Please dress your child accordingly for field trips and weather. Campers should have tight fitting, tied SNEAKERS every day. Flip flops or Crocs may be packed to wear if we go swimming.

Toys, Games, and Entertainment Devices: Please leave all personal items (electronics,toys/music players, etc) at home unless specifically requested for an activity. We cannot be held responsible for breakage or loss.

Weather: Please provide your child with protection from the sun. Sunscreen should be brought daily and labeled with your child's name. In the event of inclement weather, we will utilize our indoor facilities. Field trip decisions will be made the morning of the scheduled trip.

Behavior: Camp Fremont seeks to provide a positive and safe environment for all of its campers. Good sportsmanship, manners, teamwork, cooperation, respect, kindness, and responsibility for self, property, and others will be encouraged at all times. If a camper does not meet these expectations,

staff members will attempt to redirect the behavior through discussions and/or time-outs. If these attempts are not successful, a parent will be called and asked to pick up their child immediately. Repeat offenders will be expelled from camp. Fighting/physical contact will not be tolerated; immediate parent pick-up is mandatory. Any campers who are removed in any way are not eligible for refund or credit.

Ages: For children going into 1st grade (That have experience in a full day kindergarten environment) through going into 9th grade during the 2016-2017 school year.
