



**Fremont Cemetery Trustees  
Meeting Minutes  
June 1, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 pm in basement meeting room of the Fremont Town Hall.

Present: Cemetery Trustees Richard Rand, Roger Anderson and Recording Secretary Meredith Bolduc.

Mr. Anderson made the motion to accept the minutes of the April 6, 2009 meeting as written. Motion seconded by Mr. Rand with unanimous favorable vote.

Budget

The Trustees received and reviewed the Cemetery budget general ledger report for the date ending May 28, 2009 noting that the only expenses have been for mowing and electricity.

Cemetery Ordinance for Fremont, NH

The Cemetery Ordinance was briefly discussed and Mrs. Bolduc reported that the Public Hearing for amending the Cemetery Ordinance has not yet been scheduled.

Village Cemetery

Pump: Mrs. Bolduc reported that Town Administrator Heidi Carlson said that the question arose after Memorial Day of whether there is a need for a new pump or pump repair work at the Main Street (Village) Cemetery. It came up at the May 28, 2009 Selectmen's meeting and whether or not perpetual care could help to pay for it. Mr. Rand said that he has a nice pump that he is not using that he will donate and install in the near future.

Gates: Mr. Rand reported that Larry Lourette of Fremont Welding has not repaired and returned the two gate sections (one section at each entrance) of the Village Cemetery. He agreed to follow up and contact Mr. Lourette to find out the status of the repairs.

Loam: Mr. Rand said that he will contact Dan Olson for delivery of a truckload of loam.

New grave lots: There was a conversation relative to hiring someone to spread the existing loam/clay pile and creating up to fourteen new grave lots in the back portion of the Village Cemetery.

Repairs: There was a conversation relative to cleaning out the plugged culvert in the back of the Village Cemetery.

Leavitt Cemetery

Mr. Rand said that there is nothing new to report at this time. Mr. Anderson said he has some heavy steel bars and will start next week on repairs to gates and broken monuments.
