

NEW: ISSUING CERTIFIED COPIES OF NH DIVORCE RECORDS

Beginning Monday, January 8, 2007 all NHVRIN City/Town locations will have the ability to issue certified copies of Divorce Records that are contained in the NHVRIN database. The Fremont Town Clerk's Office is one of these locations.

The date range for these online records is from 1990 to within 6 months from the present search date (to accommodate record receipt from the NH Courts and entry by DVRA staff). Certified copies shall be issued for a \$12 search fee.

This functionality has been added to the role of the Town Clerk for the explicit purpose of issuing a certified copy of the final divorce decree as issued by a NH Court. A search and issuance of a certificate of Divorce shall be limited to an individual that has met the "Direct and Tangible interest" access policy as stated in RSA 5-C:9. This means that the Clerk cannot just log on to verify the information for you, but must charge the fee and print you a copy.

This function shall NOT be used as a tool to verify a Divorce event in place of a Certified Paper Copy as required by law when applying for a license to marry.
