Meeting Agenda

In accordance with NH RSA 91-A: 2, II, you are hereby notified that the Fremont Conservation Commission is holding a joint public hearing with the Board of Selectmen on **December 3 at 7:15 PM in the basement of the Town Hall**. You may attend this public meeting in person under specific safety guidance that is detailed on the Town's website. In accordance with State Emergency Orders, the Conservation Commission is also permitted to utilize emergency meeting provisions of RSA 91-A to conduct this meeting through electronic means while preserving, to the extent feasible, the public's right to observe and listen contemporaneously.

On this date the Conservation Commission will meet with the Board of Selectmen for a public hearing, pursuant to NH RSA 36-A: 4 and 5 and RSA 675:7, concerning the purchase of parcel 04-017 for conservation purposes. The parcel is 12 acres and is located adjacent to the Oak Ridge Town Forest and fronts on Louise Lane. Funding for the purchase is proposed to come from the Fremont Land Use Change Tax Conservation Fund and will not exceed \$6,200 including all closing costs.

If you choose to attend, you are asked to wear a mask and will be screened for entry to the Town Hall. Written comments may be submitted to the Board of Selectmen by mail, electronically to hcarlson@fremont.nh.gov or dropped off in the Town Hall drop box for the Selectmen no later than 4:00 pm on the date of the hearing.
