9:30- Members of the Fremont RC Flyers will be setting up an area to show their planes and other items. They will also be bringing two simulators for the kids to operate. This will be a great opportunity for the kids to have fun learning about this cool hobby and get some hands-on interaction.

10:30 to 12:30- The derby will begin. Same as the last two years, people coming to the derby will have access to the entire pond area to fish where they want.

12:30- There will be hotdogs, hamburgers, chips, and drinks. During lunch, there will be a prize presentation for the top three fishermen. As always, every child will leave with something to help them on their future fishing journeys.

After the presentation, please feel free to continue to fish the area. We're hoping that this is a great opportunity for all of us to enjoy some of the natural habitat we have in our town.
