NOTICE OF DECISION

You are hereby notified that at a Public Hearing, held on Wednesday November 4, 2020 at the Fremont Town Hall, attending members of the Fremont Planning Board did unanimously vote to adopt the updated Basis of Assessment of Public School Impact Fee and Fee Schedule prepared by BCM Planning LLC of Yarmouth, Maine in accordance with Article 15, Section 1514. The Public School Impact Fee shall be imposed on all new development, except for accessory dwelling units and residential units that are lawfully restricted to occupancy by senior citizens age fifty-five (55) or over. The fees shall be collected by the Town at or prior to issuance of a certificate of occupancy at varying rates per unit by based on 4 different types of building structures.
