## Town of Fremont Notice of Public Hearing

The Fremont Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on Monday March 4, 2024, at 6:30 PM in the Fremont Town Hall basement meeting room at 295 Main Street, pursuant to NH RSA 36-A:4 and 5 and RSA 675:7 concerning an increase in funding of approximately \$15,000 from Conservation Funds to cover costs for applying conservation easements on several properties including Parcel 03-059 which is under contract for donation to the Town of Fremont NH from the Joanna Pellerin Revocable Living Trust and Town Owned parcels 04-066, 04-066.001, 04-018, 04-017, and 02-151.001. These costs do not impact the tax rate. The Town of Fremont has accepted \$19,649 in grant monies for this project which will go toward these costs and plans to apply for more grant money this year.
