FRIENDS OF THE FREMONT LIBRARY FREMONT, NEW HAMPSHIRE BY-LAWS

Article I

The name of the organization shall be "Friends of the Fremont Library".

Article II

The purpose of this organization shall be to promote interest in the library and community, improve library facilities and support the library staff.

Article III

Regular meetings of the Friends of the Fremont Library will be held on the first Tuesday of every month. Special meetings may be called at the discretion of the President or Executive Board.

Article IV

Membership in this organization is open to any person interested in the objectives in Article II who provide the annual dues set forth by the membership. Membership will run from October through September. All members with the exception of library trustees shall be eligible to hold office. All members shall be eligible to vote. Each member shall have one vote.

Article V

The Officers of this organization also know as the Executive Board shall be President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Recording and Corresponding Secretary.

Article VI

The Officers of this organization shall be elected as follows: Nominations shall be taken from the floor at the September meeting. The vote shall be taken immediately thereafter. The newly elected slate of Officers will be installed at the next meeting. Elections will be held annually. If a position becomes vacant, a new Officer will be elected during the next regular meeting in the same manner.

Article VII

All proceedings will be governed by Roberts Rules of Order, Revised.

Article VIII

Amendments to these by-laws will be made by notifying the membership of changes by posting revisions in the Fremont Library for two weeks prior to a vote. A majority vote of those attending will prevail.
