TOWN OF FREMONT SELECTMEN'S ORDINANCE

PUBLIC DRINKING

PURPOSE

It is the declared intent and purpose of this ordinance to prohibit the consumption of alcoholic beverages and the possession of an open container of alcoholic beverage while on any public way or town owned property.

ACTS PROHIBITED

No person shall consume any alcoholic beverage, or have in his possession any open container of alcoholic beverage, while upon any public park, playground, sidewalk, common, town-owned property, or any public way within the geographic limits of Fremont.

No person shall consume any alcoholic beverage, or have in his possession any open container of alcoholic beverage, while in any vehicle or while upon any public park, playground, sidewalk, common, townowned property, or any public way within the geographic limits of Fremont.

Exemptions to this ordinance may be granted by the Board of Selectmen and/or Chief of Police of the Town of Fremont, provided, however, that the application for same is made in writing fifteen (15) days prior to the scheduled event.

PENALTY

A person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100) for each offense.

EFFECTIVE

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent therewith are hereby repealed.
