NH LOW & MODERATE INCOME TAX RELIEF

The State's 2012 Form DP-8 for the Low and Moderate Income Property Tax Relief is available at their website or as a link from the town's website. FIRST ISSUE TAX BILLS

First issue 2013 tax bills will be mailed out during the week of May 20th and are due by Friday July 5, 2013. Office hours are Thursday evenings from 5:00 to 7:00 pm at the Fremont Town Hall. During the collection time, additional hours will also be held:

ATTENTION DOG OWNERS OF FREMONT

This is a reminder to license any dogs which have not already been licensed. No documents are needed to renew the dog unless the rabies certificate on file has expired. Dog licenses may be renewed by mail by sending a check with the appropriate fee and a copy of the rabies certificate (if not current in our system) or online at www.fremont.nh.gov. (Choose online dog licensing – additional fees apply). You may also register in person by coming to the Town Clerk's Office M – W 9:00 am – 2:00 pm, or Th between 11:00 am – 7:00 pm. The license fees are as follows:

Puppies	Altered	Unaltered	Senior Citizen (owner 65+ years old)
4 months to 7 months old	7 months old & up	7 months old & up	Each owner/keeper limited to 1 discounted license – any age dog

Dogs registered After June 1 are assessed a penalty of \$1.00 per month. A delinquent dog list will be forward to the Board of Selectmen as of June 20, 2013. The list will then be forwarded to the Animal Control Officer for processing of a civil forfeiture fine in the amount of \$25.00 (per dog). The process for registering dogs, penalties and fines are charged according to NH State Law.

10TH ANNUAL CHILDREN'S SUMMER READING PROGRAM AT THE FREMONT PUBLIC LIBRARY!

This year is the 10th annual Children's Summer Reading Program at Fremont Library. The Summer Reading Program is a national literacy program that was developed to encourage children to read over the summer months. Research has consistently shown that if a child reads - even one book! - during summer vacation, he or she has less of a "summer learning loss" when school opens again in the Fall.

This year's theme is: "Dig Into Reading!" and we will be exploring topics such as: archaeology, geology, burrowing animals, gardens, fairy tales.

The 6-week program at the Library encourages children to read for pleasure in a variety of formats with many literacy-enhancing activities and events. The program runs June 20th thru August 1st.

Any one who is read to or reads on their own at any level is welcome to join - from toddlers to 'tweens!

Registration is required - either in person when you visit the Library, or online. Upon registering, children will receive a Game Sheet, a special Bookmark and a Reading Log to record their progress

In prior years, "Miss Lynda" has had a "store" with small prizes that children earned as they reached their reading goals. This year, "Miss Lynda" is trying something new: for every 20 minutes a child is read to or reads by himself, he will receive a ticket to put in the Chest for a Mystery Drawing at the end of the program. A child can also earn a ticket by completing an item on the Game Sheet. The Game Sheet can be adapted as needed for younger children or children for whom reading is difficult.

There will also be a **Drop In Story Time** will be held every **Thursday at 3:30 pm.** No registration required; all ages welcome.

A weekly theme-related **Craft** will also be available, materials provided.

In addition to the Mystery Drawing, any child who completes the program will receive a Special Certificate to note his accomplishment as well as a free book.

TOWN CLERK INFORMATION

VEHICLE REGISTRATION RENEWALS

When renewing your vehicle registration or boat registration in person, you **MUST** provide the Clerk's office with the current registration or the "courtesy" renewal notice that you received in the mail. This is a State law. If you do not provide either of these documents, the Clerk's office **CANNOT** process the registration renewal without first printing a certified copy of the previous registration that will cost \$18.00.

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION RENEWAL AND DOG LICENSING RENEWAL AVAILABLE ON-LINE!





Internet transactions will be accepted through a kiosk to $\underline{\text{renew}}$ your motor vehicle registrations and $\underline{\text{renew}}$ your dog licenses from your computer at home. Customers will be directed to a secure web site through the kiosk. The Town of Fremont will receive all applicable fees and there is no charge to the Town for the electronic payment. Customers are charged a convenience fee for the transaction.

All inquiries are directed through our software provider's website and there is no direct access to the Town's computers or their systems.

Also on the E-Reg site is an estimation tool to receive quick and convenient estimates for your vehicle registrations. The fees calculated are subject to change and may vary depending upon how, when and where you complete the registration process.

ID FOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS

When registering a vehicle with the Town Clerk's office you MUST present a valid photo id or driver's license in order for your transaction to be completed. This requirement has been issued by the NH Department of Safety – Fraud Unit.

VEHICLE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

When registering a **newly acquired vehicle** you MUST provide a bill of sale. The Clerk's office is required to make a photo copy of that bill of sale and submit it to the DMV. Also, when registering a newly purchased vehicle, whoever is listed as the owner or owners on the paperwork MUST appear in person at the Clerk's office to complete the transaction.

PARKS & RECREATION CAMP COUNSELORS

The Fremont Parks & Recreation Commission is accepting applications for Camp Counselors. Pay to be commensurate with experience. Camp Fremont runs from July 8 to August 16, 2013. Camp is open 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. With before and after care counselors must be available 7:30 am to 5:30 pm Monday through Friday. Counselors work alternating shifts, generally 25-35 hours per week depending on enrollment. Applications are available at the Fremont Town Hall or on the web at: www.Fremont.nh.gov on the Parks & Recreation page or the job posting page, accessible from the homepage.

Applicants must be dependable, adaptable, creative, enjoy working with children of varying abilities and ages, have good communication and problem solving skills, and be a positive role model for campers. All applicants must be, or become, certified in Child CPR and preferably certified in First Aid. Prior experience working with children is required. Applicants must possess specialized skills in the following areas: special events, arts and crafts, sports, games, management of group activities, as well as, ability to connect individually with campers, behavior management, and daily event planning and implementation. Applicants are required to pass a Criminal Background Check.

Completed applications should be returned to the Selectmen's Office at the Fremont Town Hall (295 Main Street) or by mail to PO Box 120, Fremont NH 03044-0120.

Applications should be submitted ASAP and will be accepted until the positions are filled. Interviews will be conducted beginning mid-May 2013. The Town of Fremont is an EOE.

CAMP FREMONT SUMMER PROGRAM

The Camp Fremont Summer Program will soon be accepting registrations for six week-long camp sessions. Camp Fremont is a safe environment where your child can develop emotionally, socially, and physically for the summer. With a low camper-to-counselor ratio, your child will receive lots of individual attention. Campers will participate in a variety of physical and arts & crafts activities, as well as attend field trips and be entertained by educational presenters. Each session will be offered according to an overall theme which will ensure that you are signing your child up for activities that they will enjoy. Field trips costs and a free Camp Fremont t-shirt are included in the tuition costs. Come see how much fun Camp Fremont can be!

The following sessions are being offered (themes to be announced): July 8-12, July 15-19, July 22-26, July 29-August 2, August 5-9, and August 12-16.

We are also offering before and after care for an additional fee. During this time, your child will be supervised but will not be led in structured activities.

MOSQUITO CONTROL PUBLIC NOTICE

Town of Fremont Public Health Mosquito Control Program
West Nile Virus and Eastern Equine Encephalitis

The mosquito control program began in April for the Town of Fremont. Larval mosquitoes will be controlled in areas such as marshes, salt marshes, red maple swamps, woodland pools, flooded fields, roadside ditches and flooded stormwater basins. Mosquito larvae found in street and parking lot catch basins will also be controlled. The primary control agent will be a bacterium larvacide called Vectobac (BTI) or Vectolex (Bs). This environmentally-friendly biological control is very specific to mosquito larvae and is used worldwide in mosquito control. The bacterium is naturally occurring and will not replicate in the environment. Spraying to control larvae will continue as needed until November 30, 2013. Control agents will only be applied where larvae are collected.

Town officials may decide to complete emergency adulticide (bifenthrin) spraying to parks, athletic fields, schools, and other public areas should a public health emergency dictate.
