FREMONT'S 135TH OLD HOME DAY SERVICE

Fremont's 135th "Old Home Day Service", sponsored by the Fremont Universalist Society, will be held on Sunday August 18, 2013 at 11:00 am in the Old Meeting House at 464 Main Street. People of all denominations are welcome and encouraged to attend. Thomas Repczynski of Fremont will the speaker and Louis Santucci of Epping, NH will serve as the organist. There will also be special music by the Grace Notes acappella singing group. There will be a Social Hour with refreshments at the Ellis School following the service.

In 1873 Miss Sarah A. Chase left a sum of money, the interest from the fund to be used for hosting a Universalist church service once a year. In 1878 this fund matured and on April 11th of that year a group of citizens met in the Old Meeting House and organized The Fremont Universalist Society for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of Miss Chase's will. Because of Miss Chase's will, the organization is identified as the Fremont Universalist Society. However, it is such in name only and the yearly service has evolved into an all-denominational event.

The Old Home Day services were held in the 1856 Democratic Hall for many years and then, for a time, in the 1865 Union Church. That church was destroyed in the great fire of 1921. Since that time, the services have been held in this "Old 1800 Meeting House".

The Universalist Society is now the oldest existing organization in Fremont. The Universalist Society/Old Home Day Committee membership has diminished over the years and new members are needed to help perpetuate this unique piece of Fremont history for many years to come. The members meet once a year in the spring to hear the treasurer's report and to organize the "Old Home Day Service" at the Old Meeting House which is held on the third Sunday in August. COMCAST UPDATES

Comcast has discontinued the Town's use of the head end setup in Exeter that provides for broadcast of some meetings, including rebroadcast of the Fremont School Board. We appreciate your patience as we make this transition and train some town employees to perform the basic functions.

VEHICLE REGISTRATION RENEWALS

When renewing your vehicle registration or boat registration in person, you MUST provide the Clerk's office with the current registration or the "courtesy" renewal notice that you received in the mail. This is a State law. If you do not provide either of these documents, the Clerk's office CANNOT process the registration renewal without first printing a certified copy of the previous registration that will cost \$18.00.

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION RENEWAL & DOG LICENSING RENEWAL AVAILABLE ON-LINE!





Internet transactions are accepted through a kiosk to <u>renew</u> your motor vehicle registrations and <u>renew</u> your dog licenses from your computer at home. Customers will be directed to a secure web site through the kiosk. The Town of Fremont will receive all applicable fees. Customers are charged a convenience fee for the transaction.

All inquiries are directed through our software provider's website.

Also on the E-Reg site is an estimation tool to receive quick and convenient estimates for your vehicle registrations. The fees calculated are subject to change and may vary depending upon how, when and where you complete the registration process.

ID FOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS

When registering a vehicle with the Town Clerk's office you MUST present a valid photo id or driver's license in order for your transaction to be completed. This requirement has been issued by the NH Department of Safety – Fraud Unit.

VEHICLE REG REQUIREMENTS

When registering a **newly acquired vehicle** you MUST provide a bill of sale. The Clerk's office is required to make a photo copy of that bill of sale and submit it to the DMV. Also, when registering a newly purchased vehicle, whoever is listed as the owner or owners on the paperwork MUST appear in person at the Clerk's office to complete the transaction.

BOAT REGISTRATIONS

- Once you compete all of these steps, you will get an email each time one of the items is posted to the website. When you click on the link in your email, it will take you directly to the Newsletter, or other news item you have subscribed to.

You can also subscribe to TOWN NEWS and you will be notified when any new information is posted to the homepage of the website or emergency news is posted. This includes unanticipated office closures, changes to office hours, and news updates.

You can unsubscribe at any time using the same process, except you would chose "Remove my name."

PRESS RELEASE

A Police Chief Search Committee was formed in April to assist the Selectmen in finding the Town's next Police Chief. The Committee consisted of Fremont residents including a retired law

enforcement officer, and two area Police Chiefs. The position was posted throughout the month of May and resumes were received and reviewed by the Committee in early June. Following review of submitted applications and Committee deliberation, the Committee interviewed four qualified candidates for the position.

The Committee then presented finalist recommendations to the Selectmen. The Board of Selectmen then conducted further interviews of the finalists. Following much deliberation, and consideration of the needs of the community, the Selectmen have made a conditional offer of employment to Jon Twiss as the Town's next Police Chief. Chief Twiss will come to Fremont with 28 years of experience with the Derry Police Department and a strong and varied law enforcement background.

Please help us in welcoming him to the community. It is anticipated he will start within the next several weeks.

TRUSTEE OF TRUST FUNDS VACANCY

There is currently a one year term open for Trustee of Trust Funds. This is an elected position with a current vacancy that will be filled by appointment by the Board of Selectmen. In general, the position requires attendance at quarterly Trustees meetings, review and decision-making on trust fund policy and investments, and year end annual financial reporting to the Town and State. A \$125 annual stipend is available for the position.

PART-TIME SEASONAL HIGHWAY LABORER / TRUCK DRIVER

The Town of Fremont is seeking qualified applicants for a parttime, on call, as needed position to assist with winter snow removal and maintenance operations. This position is part-time, hourly, non-exempt employee status for the Town of Fremont.
