The Selectmen will be appointing members for a Community Cable Advisory Committee tasked to develop and manage cable TV, act as intermediaries regarding contract compliance by the cable operator(s), be a point of contact for public complaints and concerns regarding cable service, and train outside residents or organizations in the use of cable equipment for public access productions.

COME VISIT THE FREMONT HISTORIC MUSEUM!

The Fremont Historic Museum will be open on Saturday September 20th from 3:00 to 5:00 pm. The Museum is located at 8 Beede Road and admission is FREE.

Fremont was originally a part of Exeter between 1638 and 1742. When Brentwood separated from Exeter, we became part of Brentwood until June 22, 1764 when POPLIN (now Fremont)

was separated from Brentwood and incorporated as its own town. The name Poplin was changed to Fremont on July 8, 1854 in honor of General John C. Fremont - the Great American West Pathfinder/Explorer during the 1840's and 1850's.

The first settlers in Fremont came as early as the 1720's. Black Rocks Mill in Black Rocks Village (now Fremont Village) was established in 1726/27 and used until the early 1920's.

Visit the Museum and learn more about the many mills, stores, businesses, prominent people and families, riots, fires, celebrations, tragedies, weather disasters, etc. that have all made Fremont such a historic and colorful town. FALL FOLIAGE HIKE - SAVE THE DATE

The Fremont Open Space Advisory Group and the Fremont Conservation Commission are holding the Fall Foliage Hike on Saturday, October 18th at 1:30 pm. The hike will showcase the NEW Cooperage Trail, which has recently been completed. The trail is a wide, gentle, 1/2 mile path (1 mile round trip) connecting the back of the cooperage housing development with Beede Hill Road. It is well suited for a wide range of walkers! Come check out the new trail and learn about how it came to be. DIRECTIONS: From Main Street (Rt. 107) take Spaulding Road all the way to the end to the cul-de-sac.

For the second part of our hike, we will relocate to the Glen Oakes Town Forest at the end of Andreski Drive (Take Main Street to Copp Drive, left on Andreski Drive). Arriving there about 2:30, we will explore the Homestead trail loop to see the effects of last winter's logging and to learn about its benefits. This 1 1/4 mile walk should be finished by 3:30 pm. Glen Oakes Town Forest has been funded and protected, in part, with assistance from the NH Land and Community Heritage and Investment Program (LCHIP) and by the NH State Conservation Committee's License Plate (Moose Plate) grant program.

You can unsubscribe at any time using the same process, and choosing "Remove my name."

NH PRIMARY - SEPTEMBER 9TH

The NH Primary Election will be held on Tuesday September 9, 2014. Polling will be at Ellis School, 432 Main Street in Fremont with polls open from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm.

Contact the Town Clerk's Office at 895 8693 or by email at FremontClerk@comcast.net for information on registering to vote. Supervisors of the Checklist will meet at the Fremont Public Library from 7:00 to 7:30 pm on Tuesday September 2 for new registrants. This the last time to register with the Supervisors of the Checklist prior to the Primary. All Supervisor sessions are held at the Fremont Public Library at 7 Jackie Bernier Drive in Fremont. The date to change your party affiliation has passed.

New registrants may also register the day of the election with the Supervisors of the Checklist. Positive proof of ID is required to register and to be able to vote.

The Town Clerk / Tax Collector Office is CLOSED on Election Day.

POLITICAL ADVERTISING SIGNS

NH RSA 664:17 Placement and Removal of Political Advertising: "No political advertising shall be placed on or affixed to any public property including highway rights-of-way or private property without the owner's consent. The candidate shall remove all political advertising no later than the second Friday following the election unless the election is a primary and the advertising concerns a candidate who is a winner in the primary. Signs shall not be placed on or affixed to utility poles or highway signs. Political advertising may be placed within State-owned rights-of-way as long as the advertising does not obstruct the safe flow of traffic and the advertising is placed with the consent of the owner of the land over which the right-of-way passes.

No person shall remove, deface, or knowingly destroy any political advertising which is placed on or affixed to public property or any private property except the owner of the property, persons authorized by the owner of the property, or a law enforcement officer removing improper advertising. State, City, or Town Maintenance or Law Enforcement Personnel may remove political advertising placed on or affixed to any public property. Political advertising removed prior to election day by state, city, or town maintenance or law enforcement personnel shall be kept for one week at a place designated by the state, city, or town so that the candidate may retrieve the items.

As it pertains to the highway right-of- way provision, the Fremont Board of Selectmen, after consultation with the Fremont Town Clerk and Moderator, has outlined the following guidelines:

- No political signs shall be placed on Town Property outside of the road right-of- way.
- Within the road right-of-way [generally 13 feet from the edge of pavement or travel way], signs may only be placed with the direct abutter's permission. This refers to the abutter on that side of the street.
- 3. At the polling entrance, unattended political signs may be placed only on the actual polling day during open polling hours [7:00 am to 8:00 pm]; and only in the designated area as determined by the Moderator. The designated area will be appropriately marked and placed in an area that will not obstruct or hinder the safe flow of traffic. (This designated area allows the Town of Fremont to abide by the Attorney General's rules). Signs shall be removed immediately following the election.
- 4. A candidate or the candidate's representative must attend all other signs which will be permitted in an area designated by the Moderator in accordance with RSA 659:43.

The Town of Fremont designates the Fremont Safety Complex as the storage location for any political advertising signs removed for improper placement; or those found after having been displaced by wind or weather conditions. Contact the Town Clerk or the Town Moderator Michael Rydeen for further information.

FREMONT SOUVENIR FLAGS

NEW VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS

When registering a vehicle that is less than 15 years old, you must provide either of the following: the title, signed by the previous owner or the title application that the dealer gave you. If you have the title, all owners MUST be present when registering, with their valid ID, to sign the title application. If you have the title application, anyone can register your vehicle for you, on your behalf, however they must present their ID.

TRANSFER OF PLATES

If you are transferring plates from your old vehicle to another one you MUST turn in the current registration for the old vehicle. This has to be sent to the state with the transfer documentation. Failure to have this document in hand will require you to purchase a duplicate at a cost of \$18.00.

Please note: PLATES CAN ONLY BE TRANSFERRED FROM ONE VEHICLE TO ANOTHER IF THE PRIMARY OWNER REMAINS THE SAME.

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION RENEWAL & DOG LICENSING RENEWAL AVAILABLE ON-LINE!





Internet transactions will be accepted through a kiosk to <u>renew</u> your motor vehicle registrations and <u>renew</u> your dog licenses from your computer at home. Customers will be directed to a secure web site through the kiosk. The Town of Fremont will receive all applicable fees and there is no charge to the Town for the electronic payment. Customers are charged a convenience fee for the transaction.

All inquiries are directed through our software provider's website and there is no direct access to the Town's computers or their systems.

VEHICLE REGISTRATION RENEWALS

When renewing your vehicle registration or boat registration in person, you **MUST** provide the Clerk's office with the current registration or the "courtesy" renewal notice that you received in the mail. This is a State law.

ID FOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS

When registering a vehicle with the Town Clerk's office you MUST present a valid photo id or driver's license in order for your transaction to be completed. This requirement has been issued by the NH Department of Safety – Fraud Unit.
