LIGHTHOUSES OF NEW ENGLAND

On Tuesday **November 19th at 6:30 PM** the Fremont Library will present an informative and enlightening program "**Lighthouses of New England and the People Who Kept Them**"

Traditional lighthouse keeping is a way of life that is fading into the past with automation. Jeremy D'Entremont, author and lighthouse historian, will present an overview of the history of New England's historic and picturesque lighthouses with a primary focus on the colorful and dramatic stories of lighthouse keepers and their families. Jeremy's presentation will feature past and present images of the lighthouses, as well as video clips. There will also be discussion of the present-day lighthouse preservation efforts of the American Lighthouse Foundation and other organizations.

Jeremy D'Entremont is a leading expert on New England's historic lighthouses. He is the author of more than a dozen books, including *The Lighthouse Handbook: New England* and *Ocean-Born Mary: The Truth Behind a New Hampshire Legend*. His website, "New England Lighthouses: A Virtual Guide," at www.newenglandlighthouses.net, was launched in 1997. He is the historian and past president of the American Lighthouse Foundation, and founder of the Friends of Portsmouth Harbor Lighthouses. He has appeared on the History Channel, the Travel Channel, Public Television, and National Public Radio speaking about lighthouses and maritime history.

WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA

Remember, Honor, and Teach is the mission of the Wreaths Across America Program. Through this program wreaths are placed on the gravesites of veterans during the holiday season. Ceremonies honoring servicemen and women, both past and present, are held at veterans memorial monuments across the nation. These events coincide with the annual ceremony and laying of wreaths at Arlington National Cemetery in our nation's capital on the second Saturday in December.

This year we would like to place wreaths on the veterans' gravesites in Fremont and East Kingston. A fundraising effort is being coordinated by Gerry Tilley, a Fremont resident, in association with the Peoples United Methodist Church in Fremont and the East Kingston Community United Methodist Church. The Fremont and East Kingston Selectmen and Cemetery Trustees have approved this project.

Approximately 225 veterans are buried in Fremont and 145 veterans in East Kingston. With your help we will be able to honor each of them with a wreath of remembrance. Wreaths cost \$15 each. Ten dollars pays for the construction and delivery of the wreath. The remaining \$5 will be used to support two local Veterans Centers that provide for the needs of our homeless veterans.

Assistance can occur in a variety of ways. Community members and groups are needed to unload the truck when the wreaths are delivered, to place the wreaths on the gravesites in December and remove them in the spring, and to purchase of one or more wreaths.

We encourage not only adult participation, but look forward to the participation of our youth. This project provides the opportunity for our children to understand that the sacrifices made by our servicemen and women have secured the freedoms we are privileged to experience in our country today. Their participation ensures that our veterans will be remembered and honored in the years to come.

Please order a wreath or volunteer your services. Your gift will not only remember and honor those veterans who have passed on, but will also provide food, shelter, and clothing for our homeless veterans.

GLEN OAKS TOWN FOREST CLOSED

The Conservation Commission is overseeing a managed timber harvest on approximately 75 acres of the Glen Oaks Town Forest with the help of Forester Charlie Moreno. A public bid process was undertaken with four respondents. The work has been awarded to Fred LeClair & Sons Logging of Fremont.

Work is anticipated to begin shortly, and while it is in progress, all trails within the marked area CLOSED during the day while logging operations are in progress. The area will be signed at the kiosk at the end of Andréski Drive and in within the cut section.

TRASH CONTRACT UPDATES

The Town's current contract with Waste Management for trash and recycling collections ends on December 31, 2013. In September, an RFP was posted for the contract for the coming years. Bids were due on October 17, 2013 and are currently being reviewed and tabulated.

TRUSTEE OF TRUST FUNDS VACANCY

There is currently a one year term open for Trustee of Trust Funds. This is an elected position with a current vacancy that will be filled by appointment by the Board of Selectmen. In general, the position requires attendance at quarterly Trustees meetings, review and decision-making on trust fund policy and investments, and year end annual financial reporting to the Town and State. A \$125 annual stipend is available for the position.

LAND USE BOARDS NEED YOUR HELP!

The Zoning Board of Adjustment and the Planning Board both have openings for Board Members and Alternate Board Members.

Are you interested in Fremont's Zoning and Planning and land use endeavors?

Are you a resident of the Town and a registered voter?

Do you have the desire and the time to dedicate to the community?

The Planning Board meets at 7:00 pm on the first and third Wednesdays of each month. In addition to hearing and working through subdivision and site plan review applications the Planning Board is responsible for the ongoing process of updating the Subdivision, Excavation, Driveway, Site Plan Review Regulations and the Master Plan. They are also responsible for the Capital Improvements Plan and for any amendment to the Fremont Zoning Ordinance to be put before the voters of the Town.

The Zoning Board of Adjustment meets at 7:00 pm on the fourth Tuesday of each month and also conducts a site visit for each application. This Board deals strictly with the Zoning Ordinance and hears requests for relief of the Ordinance in the form of applications for Special Exceptions, Variances, Appeals from Administrative Decisions, and Equitable Waivers of Dimensional Requirements.

The process for becoming a Member of any Board or Commission is for the candidate to sit in on several meetings to see if he/she feels it is something he/she wants to pursue. If the Board Members agree with the appointment, they issue a recommendation to the Board of Selectmen, the candidate meets briefly with the Selectmen and if they agree the appointment is drawn for signature by the Selectmen.

The positions require dedication, the desire to implement and work with the Town's regulations, ordinances and procedures, and a willingness to participate in community issues. This knowledge can be gained as you attend meetings and become familiar with regulations and ordinances.
