First Session of Annual Meeting (Deliberative)

You are hereby notified to meet at the Laurence Pettengill Hall, Ellis School, in said District on Saturday, the 5th day of February 2011, at nine o'clock in the morning. This session shall consist of explanation, discussion, and debate of each warrant article. Warrant articles may be amended subject to the following limitations: (a) warrant articles whose wording is proscribed by law shall not be amended and (b) warrant articles that are amended shall be placed on the official ballot for a final vote on the main motion, as amended.

Also at the first session, the School Board will hear reports of agents, auditors, and committees or officers of the School District and may pass any vote relating thereto, and any other action which may legally come before the first session may be taken.

Second Session of Annual Meeting (Official Ballot Voting)

You are hereby notified to meet at the Fremont Safety Complex at 425 Main Street, in said District on Tuesday, the 8th day of March, 2011, between the hours of 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM to vote by official ballot on warrant articles number 1 through 4.

1. To see if the Fremont School District will vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Fremont School Board and The Fremont Education Association which calls for the following changes in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels:

2. Shall the Fremont School District, if Article 1 is defeated, authorize the governing body to call one special meeting, at its option, to address article 1 cost items only?

Shall the Fremont School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$10,250,518. Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$11,115,398, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Fremont School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (Majority vote required).
