NOTICE OF DECISION

Case #015-005

You are hereby notified that at a Public Hearing held on November 17, 2015 at the Fremont Town Hall, the attending members of the Fremont Zoning Board of Adjustment did vote to grant a Variance from the terms of Article XI Section E 4 i of the Fremont Zoning Ordinance to permit an existing motorcycle shop to move from the detached building to the Fremont Machine building on the site, within the Aquifer Protection District. The Variance was granted to property located at 810 Main Street in Fremont, Parcel 02-135.001, with the following conditions:

- 1. This decision shall be recorded with reference to the current deed and shall be included in any subsequent deeds to this parcel or subdivision of this parcel.
- 2. This approval is subject to all other Local, State or Federal permits and approvals that may be required and does not relieve the applicant from the obligation to obtain such other permits.
- 3. RSA 676:17 shall apply.
- 4. The storage of any vehicles shall be on a concrete pad.
- 5. Any waste oil container shall be stored in a containment dike.
- 6. Annual water testing shall be done on the on-site well.

RESOLVED:

The following is the result of the Board's vote on the five conditions:

- 1. The Variance will not be contrary to the public interest.
- 2. The spirit of the Ordinance is observed.
- 3. Substantial justice is done.
- 4. The values of surrounding properties are not diminished.
- 5. Literal enforcement of the provisions of the Ordinance would result in an unnecessary hardship.
 - A. For the purposes of this subparagraph, "unnecessary hardship" means that, owing to special conditions of the property that distinguish it from other properties in the area:
 - (i) No fair and substantial relationship exists between the general public purposes of the Ordinance provision and the specific application of that provision to the property.
 - (ii) The proposed use is a reasonable one.
